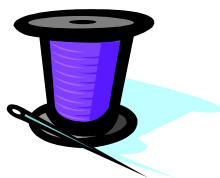
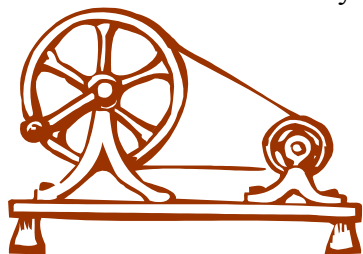
Spinners & Weavers

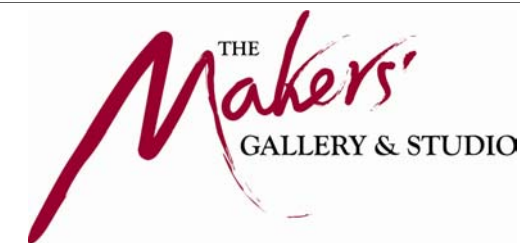


Horsham Artists Society
